Clean Sweep

Clean Sweep, a City-wide, City promoted stewardship event was held Saturday, April 22, 2023 from 9 AM – 12 PM. Over 400 individuals completed 18 projects across 16 separate sites. Volunteers worked on a handful of environmental projects around town, including projects at Auburndale Park, Brannan Park, and Cedar Lanes Park; plus clean-up activities at Mill Pond Park and Isaac Evans Park. Volunteers also worked on beautification projects at the Mountain View Cemetery, Mary Olson Farm and Fenster Nature Park. Many groups worked on landscaping and beautification projects around Les Gove Park. Volunteers at Lakeland Hills Park installed a drainage bed. While others at Sunset Park picked up litter and helped with general clean up. Planting projects took place at Game Farm Park, Veterans Memorial Park, Bi-Centennial Park, and the Historic Auburn Post Office, as well as the planter boxes along Main Street.
