

Make a Caterpillar

You will need

- Construction paper (green and yellow)
- Craft sticks or skewers
- Stick on silly eyes
- ½ of a pipe cleaner
- Tape or glue
- A pen or pencil
- Other stickers (optional)



Make your caterpillar:

- **Body:**
 - Fold your pipe cleaner in half and set aside
 - Fold the green construction paper on the solid lines
 - Cut the green paper on the dotted lines (do not cut all the way through!)
 - Place a line of glue at the edge of the paper on the wide (uncut) edge
 - Bend each cut piece over to attach to the line of glue
 - Let the glue dry a bit while making the caterpillar's face
- **Head:**
 - On the yellow construction paper, draw a circle and cut it out (trace around a bottle cap if you want!) This will be your caterpillar's face
 - Place eye stickers on the face and draw a smile
 - Tape the pipe cleaner to the back of the face (to stick out on either side of the head) you can curl the pipe cleaner around a pencil for curly antenna!
 - Tape or glue the face on the front section of the caterpillar (bend it up if you want!)
- Tape skewers (or craft sticks) to the bottom of the caterpillar at either end
- Move the sticks together and apart to make your caterpillar crawl!
