

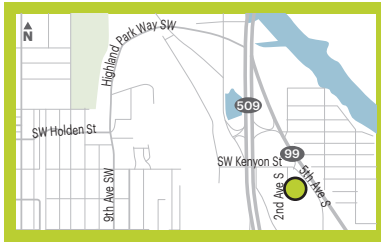

Household Hazardous Waste 101

How can you tell if something is hazardous?

Hazardous wastes come from products that usually have one or more of these **WORDS** on their labels:



These products can be unsafe for humans, wildlife, and the environment. Improper disposal can be harmful or dangerous.

As a resident of King County, you pay no additional fee for hazardous waste disposal. This service is already paid for as part of your utility bills.

Please plan ahead and note when facilities are open.
